As part of the Fatigue Management Policy, Wise Choice will apply a number of initiatives to combat fatigue. These include:


- Adequate supervision of a driver work hours

- Appropriate reporting and recording requirements
- Ongoing monitoring, development and improvement of the Fatigue Management System
- Regular audits of driver's hours and compliance to National Standards
- Supply external medical advice and support on employee's request
